



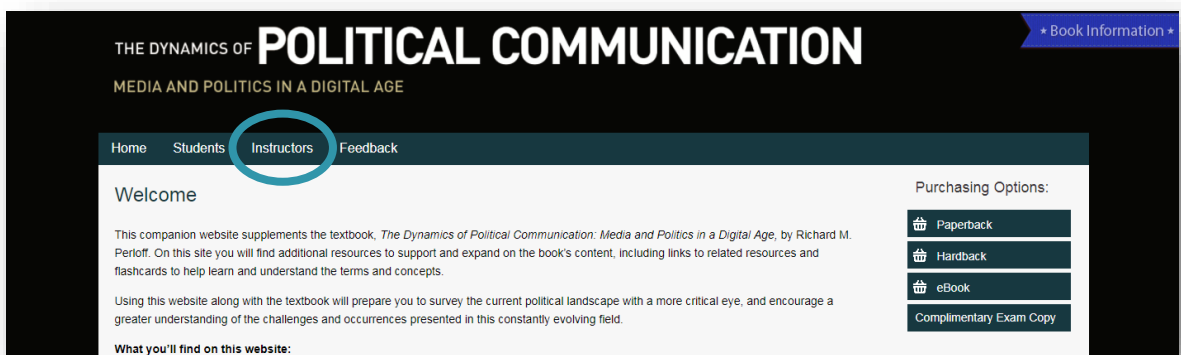
COMPANION WEBSITE ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS

INSTRUCTOR DOWNLOADS AND INTERACTIVE E-BOOKS COMPANION WEBSITES

Or through a link accessible via the page’s “hamburger menu.”

REQUEST A USERNAME AND PASSWORD.

Your Companion Website has a universal username and password affiliated with it. To obtain the username and password for your Companion Website, fill out the **“Request Password” form**.
